#### Fizz

##### Prosecco IGT, Stelle d'Italia (Italy)

£9.25

A light and frothy sparkling wine from arguably the top producer in the region. Perfect for celebrations, al fresco dining or just a glass on a summers evening.

#### White Wines

##### Chenin Blanc, Stormy Cape. (South Africa)

£6.99

A slightly "off dry" example of South Africa's most widely planted grape variety. Fruity and zesty with just a touch of background sweetness. Great with spicy food.

##### Sauvignon Blanc Montagne Noire (France)

£7.25

Typically racy example of Sauvignon Blanc from South West France. Full of grassy, lemony flavours with fresh acidity.

##### Pinot Grigio Billi Billi (Australia)

£8.25

Made by the multi award winning Mount Langi Ghiran Estate in Victoria, this modern take on the Italian classic grape varieties is ripe and rounded.

##### Chardonnay Veritiere (Italy)

£8.25

An unoaked, fruity example of a lighter style of Chardonnay from the North East Of Italy. A great "all rounder".

#### Red Wines

##### Merlot Mandrarossa (Sicily)

£7.75

Sicily is currently producing some of the best value wines around! This Merlot is no exception. Plummy, soft and juicy.

##### Shiraz Billi Billi

£8.75
